Endosalpingiosis is diagnosed by a pathologist on excision and biopsy. Endosalpingiosis is occasionally found in lymph nodes, and may be misinterpreted as an adenocarcinoma metastasis. In one study, they found that 34.5% of endosalpingiosis cases had concurrent endometriosis; 40% of the endosalpingiosis group were postmenopausal.

Although both endometriosis and endosalpingiosis are speculated to derive from the secondary müllerian system 3, 4, the demographics and clinical presentation of these two diseases was found to be very different in the present study. Endosalpingiosis appears to affect an older age group, with 40% of endosalpingiosis cases occurring in postmenopausal women.

Endosalpingiosis is surrounded by fibrous stroma; tubal type epithelial surrounded by ovarian stroma is a variant of endometriosis. Associated with psammoma bodies. Notes: Not associated with hemorrhage. In a lymph node, endosalpingiosis may be misinterpreted as a metastasis! DDX: Serous carcinoma. Peritoneal inclusion cyst. Adenocarcinoma.

In 1/3 of cases, endosalpingiosis is associated with endometriosis (Gynecol Oncol 2016;142:255) Endosalpingiosis was diagnosed in 7.6% of 1107 women undergoing laparoscopy in one study (J Am Assoc Gynecol Laparosc 2000;7:215)

Pathology Outlines - Endosalpingiosis

Endosalpingiosis may occur in pelvic organs, including ovaries, fallopian tube serosa, uterine serosa, myometrium, or pelvic peritoneum. It may also occur in the bladder or in a retroperitoneal or axillary lymph node [2]. Endosalpingiosis is not well-studied, and the clinical features remain uncertain. It has been reported to be associated with pelvic pain, infertility, pelvic mass, and/or urinary symptoms [3-6].

Endosalpingiosis of Axillary Lymph Nodes: A Rare ...

Endosalpingiosis (E5) is the ectopic peritoneal presence of glands lined by tubal-type epithelium. It differs from endometriosis (EM) in that it has ciliated glandular epithelium, no endometrial stromal component, and does not exhibit an inflammatory response.

Endosalpingiosis is defined as the presence of ectopic tubal epithelium, and the presence of a few glands in the peritoneum or the presence of many cortical inclusion cysts within the ovary may generate the diagnosis, but there may be variation in pathologic interpretation.

Endosalpingiosis: More than just an incidental finding at ...

Endosalpingiosis is a condition in which fallopian tube -like epithelium is found outside the fallopian tube. It is unknown what causes this condition. It is generally accepted that the condition develops from transformation of coelomic tissue. It is often an incidental finding and is not usually associated with any pathology.
