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Gender divides power. Inequalities between men and women are one of the most persistent patterns in the distribution of power. For example, women's lack of influence marks political decision-making the world over. Gender relations are power relations. Often what it means to be a 'woman' is to be powerless (quiet, obedient, accommodating).
