ASVAB Scores for the Army The maximum score you can receive on the ASVAB for the Army is 99. For enlistment, you must receive a minimum score of 31. Each job in the Army is given a code called Military Occupational Speciality (MOS) and each MOS has a different ASVAB score requirement.

Army ASVAB and Education Requirements. The Army requires a minimum AFQT Score of 31 to qualify for enlistment. To qualify for certain enlistment incentives, such as enlistment bonuses, an Army recruit must score a minimum of 50. The Army allows more recruits to enlist with a GED than any other branch.

Understanding Army ASVAB Composite Scores

The ASVAB consists of nine sub-tests, which the military uses to form a composite score which shows what military jobs you qualify for. The ASVAB sub-tests for determining the composites are: General Science (GS) - The General Science sub-test consists of questions on high school-level science (biology, chemistry, physics, environmental science ...

Army ASVAB Aptitude Test Standards and Scores

The ASVAB has two different kinds of scores: The Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT) score and what are known as Composite Scores or Line Scores. The AFQT score is based on a percentile system with scores ranging from 1 through 99, and is used solely to determine if enlisted applicants are qualified to join a specific branch of the military.

ASVAB — Military Aptitude Tests

The Army converts the ASVAB subtest scores into 10 composite score areas, known as "line scores." The line scores determine what job (s) an individual qualifies for.

This includes the minimum score that the job requires from the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery, or ASVAB. This test determines skills, specialties, and where exactly in the military an individual might excel. To join the Army you must obtain a minimum ASVAB score of 31. The maximum score is 99.

High school seniors or graduates must have a minimum 31 overall ASVAB score, and GED holders must have a minimum of 50 overall ASVAB score. Officers are not required to take the ASVAB test, however...

Although Army engineering jobs fall into one category, certain jobs require high ASVAB scores in various areas. A combat engineer will construct fighting positions and place explosive devices in target areas. He will need a combat score of 87 or higher.

The US Army requires a GED and AFQT score of 31 for all recruits. If you have more than 50 on the AFQT score chart, then depending on your circumstances, there are enlistment bonuses. However, if you have a GED, it's more likely you'll be accepted into the Army than any other military branch.

AFQT vs ASVAB: What's The Difference?

The ASVAB subtests use a one to 100 score range, so the mean is set to 50. This is based on a national sample of 18 to 24-year-olds. A standard deviation is a measurement of distance from the mean. The ASVAB standard deviation is set to 10.

ASVAB Scores | What Your Score Means | AFQT & Composite Score

As you can see here, the minimum ASVAB scores needed for enlistment vary somewhat among the different military branches. The Air Force and Army have the lowest minimum AFQT score (31)for high school diploma holders, while the Coast Guard has the highest (40). For all military branches, you'll need an AFQT score of at least 50 if you have a GED.
