The Disciplines of the Army Engineer Officer U.S.Army Engineer officers fall under one military occupational specialty code (MOS code). This means that engineer officers do not specialize within the regiment, and must be prepared to lead any organization within the Army Engineer discipline spectrum. This spectrum includes 20 MOS codes.
