Aged Care Assessment Services (ACAS) assess people for eligibility to access higher level services, including Commonwealth funded residential aged care, Home Care Packages, or residential respite care. An assessment is required to access Commonwealth Government funded services for older people (aged 65 and over, and Aboriginal people aged 50 and over).

You will need an ACAT assessment for respite in an aged care home. The availability of services varies from region to region, and the assessment will determine your needs in line with what help is available in your area.

Information from progress notes can be used to write client NDIS progress reports, which usually need to be submitted every 12 months. These reports help NDIS (or aged care decision-makers) with progress and care plan reviews, and these, in turn, help to guide the carers whose work it is to

implement participant goals.

The Aged Care Funding Instrument (ACFI) is managed by the Australian Government's Department of Health. ACFI is used to assess the degree of care each aged care resident needs and to allocate funding accordingly. ACFI pays subsidies to the residential aged care facility that is providing the care (National Care Solutions 2019).

Observe client interactions with peers at meal times. Take note of verbal and non-verbal communication. Notice client's mobility during the day e.g. able to sit down but needs assistance to stand up, unable to go to the toilet alone, able to drink from cup but not able to pour drink.

Client Assessment: Getting to know your Client

Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT) assessment. This team is known as Aged Care Assessment Service (ACAS) in Victoria.ⁱ Before they enter residential aged care, your client's health must be assessed to determine their eligibility for care. The assessment can be performed by any doctor, nurse or social worker who is a member of an ACAT.
