Same-Sex Intimacy in Fiction about Southern Plantations ...

A same-sex relationship is a romantic or sexual relationship between people of the same sex. Same-sex marriage refers to the institutionalized recognition of such relationships in the form of a marriage; civil unions may exist in countries where same-sex marriage does not.. The term same-sex relationship is not strictly related to the sexual orientation of the participants.
