Horses ate less (1.3 percent BW) eating without a feeder. Not using a feeder can result in herd weight loss. In the 2010 round-bale feeder study, the herds that didn't use a feeder had an average herd (3 horses) weight loss of 225 pounds. Less eating and herd weight loss without a feeder was likely due to greater hay spoilage.

Therefore, soybean hay should be fed to horses with caution and in limited amounts. Horses should be transitioned slowly to soybean forage and it should be free of mold, weeds, dust, and harvest restrictions for herbicides and other pesticides must be observed. Finally, soybean hay should be tested for nitrate accumulation prior to feeding.
