For instance AFP and HCG can be raised in the presence of a particular type of testicular cancer called non seminoma. They can also be used to measure the effect of treatment such as an orchidectomy, in reducing cancer activity which maybe present and they may be repeated after orchidectomy at 48-96 hours if they were abnormal beforehand.

Non localised testicular cancer. For cancer that has spread outside the testicle a longer course of chemotherapy for instance BEP (see below) will be suggested. The drugs most commonly used to treat testicular cancer are Cisplatin, Etoposide and Bleomycin. A combination of all three is a treatment known as BEP.

Most people start to feel better within a few weeks of treatment, but it may take at least 3 months to obtain a steady level in the blood stream and to feel the full effects of treatment. If testosterone replacement therapy does improve a man's symptoms following treatment for testicular cancer then it can be continued indefinitely.
