In her book The Sacred Hoop Paula Gunn Allen makes a rather bold statement about the position of women in American Indian cultures: she argues that "Traditional [American Indian] tribal lifestyles are more often gynocratic[i.e. governed by women] than not, and they are never patriarchal" (Allen 2).
